DESCRIPTION: This series is composed of minutes from Racing Commission meetings held May 1925 to April 1927. The minutes were created by the commission in order to maintain a record of its discussions of several issues: racing meet schedules, fees, and locations; licensing of jockies, trainers, and racing parks; pari-mutuel betting, regulations, and general operating procedures. Several letters to the commission were reproduced in the minutes because they related to topics discussed in the meetings. This series reveals much concerning the functions and operations of the Racing Commission during its two year existence.

ARRANGEMENT: Chronological by date of commission meetings.

RELATED RECORDS: This series is related to the three other series created from the documents of the Racing Commission. Series 19602, CORRESPONDENCE, is the correspondence handled by the Racing Commission, much of which was reproduced in the minutes. Series 19603, FINANCIAL RECORDS, is composed of income statements, audit reports, bank account books, and license books maintained by the Racing Commission. The financial information appears frequently in the minutes of commission meetings. Series 19604, LAWS AND AGREEMENTS, includes the rules and regulations governing the commission and dictating the daily operations recorded in the minutes.
