### FINANCIAL RECORDS, 1925#1927

**DESCRIPTION:** This series is composed of income statements, audit reports, bank account books, and license books maintained by the Racing Commission during its two year existence. There are also audits of the Utah Agricultural and Racing Association (UARA). The audits of the Racing Commission were performed by the State Auditor and independent accounting firms. The UARA audits were done by independent firms as well. The series details profits made from licensing fees, ticket sales, and pari- mutuel betting. Two ledger books record the licenses granted to jockies, trainers, and horse owners from Canada, Mexico, and thirty-one states in the U.S.

**ARRANGEMENT:** Alphabetical and chronological by name and date of book entry.

**RELATED RECORDS:** This series is related to the three other series created from the documents of the Racing Commission. Series 1194, MINUTES, includes the minutes from Racing Commission meetings held May 1925 to April 1927. The financial information appears frequently in the minutes of the commission meetings. Series 19602, CORRESPONDENCE, is the correspondence handled by the Racing Commission. Individuals requesting licenses and other financial considerations corresponded with the commission. Series 19604, LAWS AND AGREEMENTS, includes the rules and regulations governing the commission; these include fees, fines, purses, and pari-mutuel betting. The FINANCIAL RECORDS series is also related to series 240, PUBLIC DOCUMENTS SERIAL SET. Two volumes of the set, 1925#1926 and 1926#1928, contain reports from the Utah State Fair Association which recorded the Racing Commission' s profits gained from horse racing and pari-mutuel betting.
